## **Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

This is how we conjugate this tense:

Present Perfect of 'to be' + Present Participle Form of Verb

## **Examples:**

Paul has been reading for 2 hours.

She has been doing her homework.

We use the Present Perfect Continuous tense in two ways.

- 1. To talk about an event which started in the past and is continuing now. We often use the words 'for' and 'since' with this tense.
- I have been learning English for six years.

  My brother and his wife have been living in Paris since July.
- 2. We use it to talk about an event which lasted for some time and finished recently. The effects of this event are still apparent.

Why are you tired? I have been running for two hours.

I have been cleaning the house this weekend.

Why is the grass wet? **Has it been raining**?
